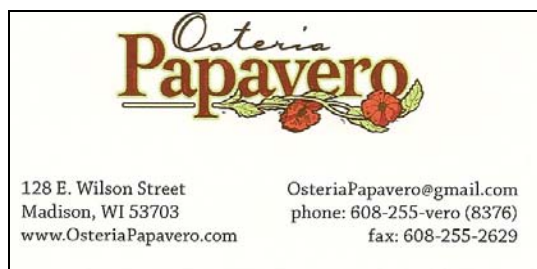

Reservations: Fill out this form ASAP and send it along with your deposit to reserve your space. Note that this tour is first-come first-serve, and will take place on a 10 participant minimum basis.

Deposit: A deposit of \$500 per person (check made out to SUITE RETREATS) is required and needs to be sent with your Reservation Form. We will hold your check until the minimum of participants is reached. At this point we will notify you, your check will be deposited and not be refundable.

Air (optional): If choosing to fly with the group this payment is also due at this time. If you elect to make your own air travel arrangements instead, you can join us at our B and B on Wed, May 27.

Final Payment: Balance \$1,750 is due by MARCH 25, 2009 (check made to SUITE RETREATS). If choosing Single Supplement, add \$450 to balance due.

Cancellation and Refund: If a written notice of cancellation is received from a tour participant between March 25 - April 24, 2009, 50% of the balance due (excludes the refund) will be refunded. NO REFUNDS for cancellations received after April 25, 2009.

DEPOSIT INFORMATION

Unless otherwise defined in published itineraries, a deposit of US \$500.00 is required upon booking your trip. The receipt of this deposit must be at the time of booking. Deposit towards booking constitutes full knowledge and acceptance of Suite Retreats specific tour's cancellation policy. Deposit is non-refundable.

BALANCE DUE

The balance is due by the date specified in the specific Tour Terms and Conditions. Space is subject to cancellation if balance payment is not received in time.

LATE BOOKINGS

Late booking requests may occasionally occur. Booking is subject to Suite Retreats' confirmation of space availability. If booking is confirmed, we require full payment to be made at the time of the booking.
